

U. Restrooms

Public Restroom Facilities:

The City of Salina provides access to seasonal restroom facilities at some of our public event spaces and park facilities.

Campbell Plaza, Spilman Plaza, and Strand Plaza in the ACE District are within walking distance of public restrooms, which are open between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. daily.

Park restrooms are also seasonal and typically open from early April until late October. However, year-round heated restrooms are available in Berkley Family Recreational Area, Bill Burke Park, Jerry Ivey Park, Magnolia Soccer Complex, and Oakdale Park. Restrooms in Oakdale Park are locked overnight.

NOTE: Public restrooms may be closed at any time at the discretion of the City of Salina, Parks & Recreation Department, or Salina Downtown, Inc. (SDI).

Portable Restroom Facilities:

If your event does not have access to public restroom facilities, you are required to provide portable restrooms to accommodate your event attendees. You may also be required to provide portable restrooms if existing public restrooms at your event site are inadequate to support large special events.

The [Portable Sanitation Association](#) provides standards for using portable restrooms at special events and a calculator to determine the necessary quantity required for your event. It is always better to over-plan when making estimations. Portable restroom calculations assume:

- one portable restroom provides approximately 200 uses, and
- each attendee will use the restroom once every four hours.

All portable restrooms must be delivered clean, deodorized, and fragranced. Multi-day events may require daily servicing. It is also recommended that portable hand washing stations accompany your portable restrooms. Please work with your local portable restroom vendor to ensure adequate facilities.

NOTE: The City of Salina reserves the right to require inspection of proper installation and removal of your portable restrooms.
