*For special events occurring in an Arts, Commerce, and Entertainment (ACE) District public plaza, the Salina Downtown, Inc. (SDI) will assist the City of Salina in evaluating the proper set-up before events and site cleanliness at the conclusion of events. To encourage good stewardship of these spaces, the City requires a \$100 deposit for ACE District public plazas, which will be returned upon SDI inspection and satisfaction with site clean-up.

**Many City of Salina Parks & Recreation public facilities, especially shelters and some neighborhood center spaces, do not always require a Special Event Permit to reserve. However, using park shelters or renting a Neighborhood Center facility space under their normal, intended use still requires a Facility Use Permit from the Parks & Recreation Department. Park shelters are available to rent hourly with a minimum 2-hour block and can be reserved online. The fee to reserve a shelter is \$11 an hour. Reservations are suggested and can be made one (1) year in advance on a first-come, first-served basis. Neighborhood Centers are also available on a first-come, first-served basis with a fee of \$17 an hour. These Neighborhood Center spaces also require a key deposit of \$100 that will be returned once the facility's good condition is verified by City staff. Reservations for both Neighborhood Centers and park shelters can be made here.

[†]Reservations are restricted at these facilities and locations. These sites require approval by the City of Salina Parks & Recreation Department and/or Salina Municipal Golf Course to avoid conflicts with their own programs and events.

NOTE: Other permits and/or licenses may be required depending on the details of your event. Date and location requests, whether through the Facility Use Permit or Special Event Permit Application processes, will be reviewed by City staff to avoid scheduling conflicts. The Special Event Permit Application will require you to provide reservation confirmation of your location (if applicable) before your application can be approved.
